

#### 1.2 INTENDED PURPOSE

The shower chair is used to make it easier for people with reduced mobility to take a shower on firm, level and slip-resistant surfaces. The product is designed for a maximum user weight of 100 kg. The product is exclusively intended for domestic use.

The product is not suitable for persons who are smaller than 146 cm or weigh less than 40 kg (BMI < 17) and must not be used by children. The product is not suitable for use as permanent seating. It is not to be used to transport persons or loads.

#### 1.3 INDICATIONS

This product is suitable for persons with physical limitations who are unable to take a shower while standing:

- ▼ Standing and inability to stand
- ▼ Standing and instability
- ▼ Loss of / defective / deformed limbs

#### 1.4 CONTRAINDICATIONS

The product is unsuitable in the case of:

- ▼ Perception disorders
- ▼ Severe disequilibrium
- ▼ Inability to sit
- ▼ A body weight exceeding 100 kg

#### 2.1 SCOPE OF DELIVERY

The product is wrapped in protective film at the factory and is supplied in a cardboard box.

Upon receipt of the goods, please immediately check to make sure that the contents are complete and undamaged. If the contents are noticeably damaged, inform the freight company immediately.

#### 2.2 EXEMPLARY REPRESENTATION

- 1. Recessed grip (with TOMTAR DS model)
- 2. Backrest (with TOMTAR DS model)
- 3. Backrest tube (with TOMTAR DS model)
- 4. Seat surface (with recessed grips on the outside)
- 5. Telescopic leg
- 6. Spring-mounted button
- 7. Suction foot



#### 2.3 ACCESSORIES

No accessories are provided for the product.

#### 3.1 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The assembly and the functional check are to be performed by the specialist dealer. The dealer's technician adapts the product to the respective user.



#### NOTE

Read the user manual before assembling and using the product.

#### 3.2 TOOLS

The following tools are required for the assembly:

- ▼ Cross tip screwdriver
- 3.3 Assembly TOMTAR DH
- 1. Place the seat with the underside pointing upwards on a clean, flat and stable surface (floor or table) (Fig. 2).
- 2. For mounting the telescopic legs, they are arranged crossed on the underside of the seat. The telescopic leg numbered 1 is placed at the bottom (Fig. 2, 1) and the telescopic leg numbered 2 (Fig. 2, 2) is placed above it and fixed in the centre (Fig. 2, 3). Use the following parts for this:
  - $1 \times$  washer,  $1 \times$  screw 35 mm.
- Screw the telescopic legs to the seat surface using the four remaining drill holes (Fig. 2, 4).
   Use the following parts for this:
  - $4 \times$  washers,  $4 \times$  screws 35 mm.



#### WARNING

**Risk of trapping:** Take care of your hands/fingers during the entire assembly.



#### 3.4 Assembly TOMTAR DS

- 1. Place the seat with the underside pointing upwards on a clean, flat and stable surface (floor or table) (Fig. 2).
- 2. For mounting the telescopic legs, they are arranged crossed on the underside of the seat. The telescopic leg numbered 1 is placed at the bottom (Fig. 2, 1) and the telescopic leg numbered 2 (Fig. 2, 2) is placed above it and fixed in the centre (Fig. 2, 3). Use the following parts for this:
  - $1 \times$  washer,  $1 \times$  screw 35 mm.
- 3. The next step is to bring the holes of the telescopic legs and those of the backrest tubes into alignment and screw all components to the seat surface (Fig. 3, 1). Use the following parts for this:
  - $4 \times$  washers,  $4 \times$  screws 55 mm.
- 4. For mounting the backrest, bring the holes of the backrest and the backrest tubes into alignment and screw the components together (Fig. 4, 1).

Use the following parts for this:

 $4 \times$  washers,  $4 \times$  screws 30 mm.



#### WARNING

Risk of trapping: Be careful with your hands/ fingers during assembly.




#### 4.1 Adjusting seat height

- 1. The product can be adjusted in height. For this purpose, press in the spring-mounted buttons on the telescopic legs (Fig. 5, 1).
- 2. Adjust the telescopic legs to the desired length (Fig. 5, 2) until the spring head emerges from the hole again and locks in place (Fig. 5, 1).




#### WARNING

**Risk of trapping:** Be careful of your fingers when adjusting the telescopic legs.

**Risk of accident:** Ensure that the spring-mounted buttons on the telescopic legs emerge again at a hole and lock in place after shifting.

**Tipping danger:** Adjust all 4 telescopic legs to the same length.



#### 4.2 Raise product

- 1. Before raising the product, all suction feet must be detached from the floor. To do this, pull the nose of the suction foot (Fig. 5, 3).
- 2. Leave the loosened suction foot raised to prevent it from sucking on the floor again.



#### WARNING

**Risk of accident:** To prevent the spring button and screws from coming loose during use, do not attempt to lift the chair without first venting the suction feet.

**Risk of accident:** The product may only be raised unoccupied, using the two recessed grips on the seat surface (left/right).\_\_\_\_\_

#### 4.3 Getting in and out

- Ensure that there is enough room to move when positioning the shower seat. Both legs must stand securely and there must be no obstacle to occupying the chair.
- 2. Sit in the middle (Fig. 6, 1) between the recessed grips (left/right, Fig. 6, 2) on the seat surface. If necessary, have someone help you sit down or stand up.



#### WARNING

**Tipping danger:** Please note that body movements shift the centre of gravity and can increase the risk of the product tipping over.

**Tipping danger:** Do not stand with your feet on the seat.

**Risk of trapping:** Never sit astride the seat. **Risk of accident:** Do not allow any oily or highly soapy substances to come into contact with the suction feet.

The product might otherwise slip away.



#### 4.4 TRANSPORT

The product is not a device for frequent transport. Should it be necessary to transport the chair, we recommend disassembling it according above assembly instructions in reverse. The product should be packed such that it is in a stable position and there is no danger of sudden and dangerous movements in the means of transport.

#### 4.5 ACCESSORIES AND ADD-ONS FROM EXTERNAL SUPPLIERS

There are no accessories available from DIETZ for this product. Generally, only original accessories from DIETZ GmbH are permitted to be used. If third-party products are installed on the product, responsibility for the safety of the product passes to the person who installs the accessories or carries out the installation. A new declaration of the compliance of the combination of accessories or add-on and product is then to be made by the person who attaches it. The compliance declared by DIETZ according to MDR 2017/745, Annex I-III shall expire.







#### **6.1 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

When using the product, always observe the following safety instructions to prevent falls, hazardous situations and damage to the product:

- ▼ The product is only to be used indoors and on a firm, level surface.
- Do not use the product as a climbing aid or stand on it.
- ▼ Do not load the product unevenly.
- ▼ There is a risk of slipping off when sitting down and standing up in wet bathtubs or shower areas, particularly when shower additives (e.g. soap or shower gel) are used.
- ▼ Check the product for damage before each use. Do not use a damaged product.

- ▼ Each time after the shower chair is disassembled and reassembled, check its stability and ensure that all telescopic legs are set to the same length.
- If your mobility is severely limited, use the product with the aid of an accompanying person.
- ▼ The surface of the product may become hot due to hot water or exposure to sunlight. Risk of burns!
- Any severe incidents associated with the product must be reported to the manufacturer and responsible authority.

#### 7.1 SERVICING/MAINTENANCE

We recommend performing the inspections listed in the maintenance schedule at regular intervals to ensure that the product is always safe to use.

Failure to ensure care and maintenance or insufficient care and maintenance of the product leads to a restriction of liability. The maintenance schedule does not provide any information on the amount of work that will actually need to be performed on the product.



#### NOTE

As the user, you will be the first to notice any damage. If you notice a fault as described in the maintenance schedule or further defects and functional impairments, contact an authorised specialist dealer immediately.



#### WARNING

Repairs on the product must only be performed by specialist shops using DIETZ original spare parts to maintain the operational safety of the product. The relevant spare parts catalogue can be found on our website in the information of the product in question.



#### NOTE

The inspections and measures stipulated in the maintenance schedule must be performed by the user or assistant if not otherwise stated.

#### 7.3 CLEANING

To clean the product, use lukewarm water mixed with a mild detergent (without solvents and with a pH value of 5-9). After cleaning, wipe with clear water and then dry the product with a cloth.



#### WARNING

**Material damages:** Do not use high-pressure cleaners, strong, corrosive chemicals or scouring agents for cleaning purposes.

**Risk of corrosion:** To avoid corrosion, ensure that all materials dry completely after cleaning. \_

#### 7.4 DISINFECTION

Wipe down or spray all components thoroughly with commercially available surface disinfectant. Take particular care to disinfect surfaces that come into frequent contact with hands/skin, such as the seat surface, backrest and armrests. Please only use the following disinfectants; use of other chemicals might damage the product.

 Aldehyde-free disinfectants based on alcohol (max. 70% propyalcohol)



#### WARNING

Material damages: During disinfection, observe the use and application instructions issued by the cleaning agent / disinfectant manufacturer.

Risk of infection: The product must be disinfected before each user change.

#### 7.5 DISPOSAL

If you no longer need the product, please contact your specialist dealer. They will then pick up the product and either dispose of it properly or make further use of it. Otherwise, please take the product to your local waste disposal facility.

#### 7.6 FORWARDING/REUSING

Your product is suitable for transfer to/reuse by others. The number of times it can be reused depends on the material wear conditions and the functional capabilities of the respective product. When handing over the product or re-using it, please remember to hand over to the new user or the specialist dealer all the technical documents necessary for safe handling.

Before being re-used, the product must be cleaned and disinfected, and must be checked for damage and approved by a specialist retailer. To do this, all test points listed in the maintenance plan must be checked on the product.

#### 7.7 STORAGE

To store the product, ensure that it is stored in a dry place protected against direct, strong sunlight and at a temperature of 0°C to +45°C. When in storage, secure it against unwanted movement or toppling over.

After longer periods of storage (> 4 months), please check all the inspection points on the product listed in the maintenance schedule before reusing/redeploying the product.



#### WARNING

**Material damages:** Do not store the product near a heat source and do not place any objects on the product during storage.

#### 8.1 WARRANTY

Warranty services refer to all product defects which are verifiably attributable to material or manufacturing flaws. The warranty period is 24 months as of receipt of notification of readiness for shipping, but following delivery at the latest.

Damage which has occurred due to natural wear, intent, and negligent or improper operation or usage is excluded from the warranty obligation. This also applies to the use of unsuitable care products, lubricating oils or greases.

#### 8.2 LIFETIME

The expected product service life is five years when used daily and if used as intended. This assumes compliance with the maintenance and

safety specifications stipulated in this manual. The indicated life span does not constitute additional guarantee.

#### 8.3 LIABILITY

We recommend that the products be handled appropriately and cared for according to the instructions.
